



# Clerk's Vacancy

Tilston Parish Council is seeking an enthusiastic and motived person to be employed as the Clerk and Responsible Financial Officer for what is a very active Parish Council.

The post will provide the right candidate with an interesting, challenging and rewarding position allowing them to make a real difference in the community.

# Slow the Flow

Councillors are investigating whether it is possible to introduce a 'slow the flow' scheme on the Brook which runs through Tilston, the aim of the scheme would be to create natural barriers up stream of Tilston which would hold water back during times of high flow rates to reduce the risk of flooding in the village itself. Such schemes have helped mitigate flooding in other areas by introducing leaky dams and creating areas where water can be held. Schemes can also increase the biodiversity along Brooks and rivers.

The project is at the very early stages and will require the support of landowners as well as the Environment Agency, anyone who would like to be involved should contact the Clerk.

# News from St. Mary's, Tilston and St. Edith's, Shocklach – May 2022



# St Mary's Bell Ringers

# ! BIG NEWS! BIG NEWS! BIG NEWS! BIG NEWS! BIG NEWS.

We have waited to the last minute to put in our entry for "The Reporter" this month so we are able to report on an attempt by three of our ringers to ring a Quarter Peal this very afternoon (18<sup>th</sup> April 2022) with the help of three friends from two other local towers. For Jill, our hard-working Tower Captain it was her first attempt at a "Quarter", and for Jo, it was her first time ringing one on a "working bell", Jo has



rung one before on the 8<sup>th</sup> April 2002 in Warburton, Greater Manchester so 20 years ago almost to the day when she rang the Treble (smallest bell) to the same method rung today.

Despite a few "wobbles" at times, which were swiftly corrected by the "Conductor", Simon Christian from Tarporley and/or his wife Jenny who rang the Treble for us, and we completed the 1260 changes required to complete the composition of the method called Plain Bob Doubles in about 39 Minutes. Ian Orme from Tattenhall came over and kept us moving at a fair rate ringing the Tenor and when we finished there were both smiles of relief and satisfaction all round!

We will be putting a notice into the database of ringing called Bellboard (https://bb.ringingworld.co.uk) as a permanent record of the occasion. If you go to the bellringing section of St Mary's website then there is link that shows all the peals and recorded ringing events that have taken place at St Mary's that have been entered back to 1977 (Note: If anyone has any information or records of peals or ringing before this, then we would be delighted to have them so the records there can be entered and added for posterity ).

In Church on Sunday, the quarter peal attempt was announced, and a few people commented afterwards, it certainly made me smile when asked "How will we know you've gone wrong, will it when we hear Chords!" .. All I can say John is that there were a few today, but I suspect you couldn't tell me the key!

So, that's the excitement over and reported!

I mentioned above that the Method ( the sequence of changes ) was called "Plain Bob Doubles", as of today there are 23,275 methods that are registered in the Central Council of Church Bell Ringers (CCCBR) method library, these are all unique and cover everything from two to twenty-two bells, your bit of information for this month is that the "Doubles" at the end indicates how many bells are required to ring the selected method, "Doubles" means 5 bells, so today we rang 6 bells but only the first 5 were moving order, the heaviest bell ( the Tenor ) just stayed put and "Bonged" at the end of each row.

Taking this a small step further, the "Plain Bob" method when rung on 6 Bells is called "Plain Bob Minor" so Minor means that 6 Bells are changing places (moving in the order) at every pull of the rope. Taking this a few steps forward, "Triples" is 7 Bells, "Major" is 8, "Caters" is 9 and so on ... you never know what will come up in that Pub Quiz!

Remember, if you fancy finding out more, getting involved, or just having a go at ringing then just drop our Tower Captain a line (jill.farmer@elginhill.com - 01829 250471), or pop along on a Thursday night when you hear the bells ringing on our practice night from 7:30pm to 9.00pm, we would be delighted to see you.

# Shocklach Oviatt C of E Primary School Newsletter November 2021

The sun is beginning to shine, and we are making the most of our beautiful, rural setting at Shocklach, enjoying the great outdoors at every opportunity as Spring blossoms all around us. We also strive for the highest academic, artistic, sporting and social successes for all of our pupils, recognising and celebrating the individuality and achievements of all. There is always such a lot to celebrate which makes my job as Headteacher a wonderful one.



The empathy and courageous advocacy shown by Shocklach children is exemplary. A movie night and non-uniform day was organised to raise money to donate to the Polish Integration Support Centre which is based in Chester, Wrexham and Merseyside. These centres have been arranging to transport lorryloads of donations to Poland to help those fleeing the war in Ukraine. The £200 that school raised will contribute to fuel costs as well as vital supplies. Those affected by the war remain in our prayers.

We are proud to be one of the first schools in CWAC to become a Milk and water only school. Give up Loving Pop (GULP) is a campaign from Food Active which aims to help people cut back on sugary drinks by raising awareness of the health harms of over consumption of Sugar Sweetened Beverages and by informing people of the benefits of drinking alternatives such as water and milk.

Consuming too many foods and drinks high in sugar leads to weight gain and related health problems, such as type 2 diabetes and heart disease as well as tooth decay. Switching from sugary drinks and promoting milk and water as alternatives, leads to numerous benefits: promoting children's health; increased concentration and cognitive performance; improved sporting performance; and a positive impact on the environment by reducing single use plastics.

Shocklach has adopted this philosophy as part of a wider whole school approach to promoting health and well-being. As part of the project, all children have received a GULP (Give Up Loving Pop) water bottle which they LOVE filling up from our chilled water dispenser! Badgers class recently designed and made their own healthy flatbread snacks, trying new, healthy foods.





Instead of Science Week, at Shocklach we have enjoyed 'Science month' completing many fascinating science activities.

The standard of work on display at Bishop Heber Science Fair was phenomenal. We are incredibly proud of our Shocklach scientists who showcased their interests ranging from making bread, to hamsters to grass growing. The whole school thoroughly enjoyed a session with Fun Science West Lancs involving a whole range of spectacular science!

A secret scientist visited Squirrels class to teach them all about acids and alkalis – there were lots of gasps of wonder!

There are certainly some inspiring, budding scientists in our midst.















Our weekly 'Buddy day' provides countless precious moments where older children nurture the younger ones and younger children learn to become more confident. Observing and facilitating these relationships is priceless and never ceases to raise a smile.

Ronnie – our school dog – is earning his crust with his canine therapy sessions which the children benefit from hugely.






