Become a Councillor

Parish Council elections take place every four years. The next election will take place on Thursday 4th May 2023.

No Mans Heath and District Parish Council has seats for 11 councillors which need to be filled.

If 11 people or less put their names forward to sit on No Mans Heath and District Parish Council they will automatically be elected and no voting will take place.

If 12 or more people put their names forward to sit on No Mans Heath and District Parish Council an election and voting will take place to fill the 11 seats.

What do Parish Councillors do?

- Represent your local community
 - Serve your local community
- Work with the principal authority (CWaC)
- Make decisions that affect your local community
 - Make a difference to your local community

How to stand for election?

To stand for No Mans Heath and District Parish Council you will need to complete an application form. The application form must be signed by two people who are on the Electoral Register for No Mans Heath and District.

The Nomination Pack is available from Cheshire West and Chester Council (CWaC) or the Clerk to No Mans Heath and District Parish Council.

The application form must be submitted by hand to CWaC by 4pm on Tuesday 4th April 2023.
