**1. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE.** None received.

i) Defibrillator update: Cllr Bowles reported that consumables were in hand but that there were concerns regarding any loss of power at The Bull as it was now closed. In this instance the cabinet would fail but he would keep checking on it.

iii) Dog fouling: a complaint was made about fouling along the Bishop Bennett Way. Cllr Roberts suggested trying the Pink Poo Campaign as a deterrent but it was felt that this would have little effect in the location.
