We would like to provide a further update on our works along Chester Road, Churton. The road closure currently in place will remain until 4pm on Friday 28 August 2026. At this time, the closure will be removed and replaced with temporary traffic signals, which will remain in operation throughout the Bank Holiday weekend until 8am on Tuesday 1 September 2026.

From 8am on Tuesday 1 September, the road closure will be reinstated to allow us to safely complete the next phase of work. This closure will remain in place until 4pm on Tuesday, when temporary traffic signals will once again be used overnight until 8am on Wednesday 2 September 2026. From 4pm on Wednesday, the road closure will be removed, and we will continue working under temporary traffic signals along Chester Road until further notice.

We also have some good news to share. Eaton Road, Eccleston reopened to all traffic at 12pm today (Friday 28 August 2026). We know the road closure has caused disruption for residents and road users, and we would like to thank everyone for their patience and understanding while these essential works have been carried out. Reopening the road is an important milestone for the project, and we are pleased to be able to restore normal access on this route.
